### Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 235A

- Only the section of the path along the approximate line of the entrance drive to the reservoir is shown on the map with the Northfield Tithe Apportionment of 1840. (Held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library.)
- The whole path is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1884).
- The path is shown on the deposited plans for the Birmingham, Kidderminster and Stoke Railway 1889. The Book of Reference describes parcel No.5 in Frankley as 'Field and footpath'. (Held by Warwickshire County Record Office at OS111/452.)
- The path was diverted when Frankley Reservoir was built c.1891, although the plans have not been found.
- The deposited plans of 1927 for Bartley Reservoir show the path, as diverted, including the access road. (Held by Warwickshire County Record Office at OS111/607.)
- The part of the diverted path around Frankley Reservoir in Worcestershire is shown on the Ordnance Survey Pathfinder maps (sheets 834 (1986) and 954 (1988)) as a public footpath, the information having been taken from the Definitive Map.
- 7 The path is recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
