

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 177

- The footpath is first recorded in 1802/1803 when it was the subject of proposed Quarter Sessions Diversion Orders which would have moved he path to the south. (There are two such Orders due to the then position of the County boundary. These are held by Warwickshire County Record Office under reference QS47/Roll 2/membrane 10 = QS47/22, and in the Staffordshire County Record Office under reference QSB/Ep. 1803.)
- 2 The Orders were not implemented, however, since the original route is shown on the first edition (1880's) of the Ordnance Survey 6 inch maps.
- 3 The route is generally well maintained and is well used, as can be seen from the physical evidence on the grass verge section, with street lighting rather than path illumination.
- 4 The route is recorded o the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- 5 It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
