

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 223

- The path is first recorded on the map with the Northfield Tithe Apportionment of 1840. (Copy held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library.)
- 2 It is also shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1880's).
- 3 It is again shown, and labelled, on a Quarter Sessions Highways Order of 1929. (Held by the Central Reference Library, Archives section, under reference QS/B/21/1 (Box 14, Bundle 3, item 15).)
- The section east from St Helens Road, crossing Lockwood Road, was closed by diversion onto new streets, with a footpath link east from Hilary Grove to the retained east end of the path, by a Quarter Sessions Highways Order made on 16 August 1934 (Ref. QS/B/21/2 (Box 15, item 56).)
- The east end of the path (south east from Ulwine Drive, now the line of the Northfield Relief Road) was closed and replaced (with Path Claim BAP 224) by a single path by a Quarter Sessions Highways Order of 1957, the Certificate of Completion being dated 7 May 1958. (Ref. QS/B/21/8 (Box 21, item 3).)
- 6 This (remaining) section of path is shown on he Ordnance Survey Pathfinder map (sheet 954 of 1988).
- 7 This path is recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- 8 It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
