This will enable the service to concentrate spending against statutory and essential services. This is a reduction in general none-pay discretionary budgets across Adult Social Care with no staff impacted. This reduction is based on the unused inflation that was provided to budget holders as part of the 2024/25 budget setting process and the reductions in discretionary expenditure across the Directorate due to the continuation in 24/25 of S151 spend controls. No specific third sector providers are impacted by this saving which is a general reduction in discretionary none-essential expenditure.
