## Discussion:

- The meeting began with introductions of various delegates, each representing different educational and professional backgrounds. They discussed their roles and contributions to the educational system in Birmingham, the importance of data sharing, and the need for a unified vision and purpose.
- Data Sharing Agreement: There was an extensive discussion on the importance of data sharing agreements among schools and other educational institutions to improve decision-making and support for children.
- The role of data in informing decisions and improving educational outcomes was also discussed, with an emphasis on the need for accurate and timely data.
