

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 330

- The path is first recorded on the 1887 edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch and 1/2,500 maps, the west half being shown as wide as a road.
- The 1917 edition of the 1/2,500 map, sheet 4.15, labelled the path 'FP', with a house on its south side at its west end taking up the rest of the wide section.
- The path has a well maintained tarmac surface with 'no cycling' and 'public footpath' signs, and a modern street light. There are also a number of manholes and a water stopcock in the path, which is suggestive of it being public since they require access at all times for maintenance.
- The path is recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
