What is 'Sutton Connect'?

Sutton Connect is building a Green Travel District in Walmley, Minworth and Reddicap. That will mean it's easier and more pleasant to walk, wheel, cycle and use public transport to get where we are going.

When more people walk, wheel, cycle or use public transport we make a healthier, safer and more productive community, and we reduce pollution and congestion for everyone travelling in the district as well.

The new Peddimore Employment Park and Langley Sustainable Urban Extension (SUE) housing development will bring new jobs, homes, schools and community facilities to Sutton Coldfield, along with the opportunity to improve travel in the district.


Sutton Connect Partnership Board

Our Green Travel District brings together a partnership of businesses and community organisations to form Sutton Connect, working with Birmingham and Sutton councils to make it easier to travel for everyone. The Partnership board coordinates our efforts to ensure we can all safely walk, wheel, cycle, or use public transport in Walmley, Minworth and Reddicap area, whilst exploring opportunities to make better connections with adjoining areas.

The **Sutton Connect Partnership Board** delivers:

- Travel Planning support for workplaces to enable people to travel sustainably
- Communication that raises awareness of sustainable travel options and encourages their uptake
- Assembling (including commissioning where appropriate) and interrogating the necessary data to inform its understanding of travel habits in the Green Travel District area
- Monitoring and management of the contributions of developers to ensure they mitigate the travel impact of new businesses and homes
- Recommendations to Birmingham City
 Council for changes to the Langley and
 Peddimore Infrastructure Development Plan
- Governance to secure a lasting legacy of sustainable travel and secure additional funding required to deliver this.
