- (a) Atlas Depot, 70/72 Kings Road, Tyseley, Birmingham, B11 2AS;
- (b) Lilford Lane Depot, Ebury Road, Kings Norton, Birmingham B30 3JL;
- (c) Perry Barr Depot, Hottford Orms, Birmingham, B42 2TJ;
- (d) Smithfield Depot, Sherlock Street, Birmingham, B5 4PX;

and/or

(2) block or obstruct any of the claimant's waste collection vehicles engaged in waste collection services within the City of Birmingham.

The application does not prohibit any protesting activity that does not seek to block or obstruct the provision of waste collection services in the City of Birmingham nor to limit lawful picketing and related activity carried out in accordance with the existing injunction granted by the High Court against Unite and in favour of Birmingham City Council (dated 27 May 2025, extended on 29 May and applied to the Smithfield Depot on 25 June 2025).

The application will be heard on a date to be notified separately at which representations will be able to be made.

Take Notice: If the application is granted, anyone breaching the injunction could be imprisoned for up to 2 years, fined, and/or have their assets seized for contempt of court.

- (a) Atlas Depot, 70/72 Kings Road, Tyseley, Birmingham, B11 2AS;
- (b) Lifford Lane Depot, Ebury Road, Kings Norton, Birmingham B30 3JL;
- (c) Perry Barr Depot, Hottard Drive, Birmingham, B42 8TU;
- (d) Smithfield Depot, Shercock Street, Birmingham, B2 9JK.

and/or

(2) block or obstruct the claimant's waste collection vehicles engaged in waste collection services within the City of Birmingham.

The application is made to prohibit protesting activity that does not seek to block or obstruct the provision of waste services in the City of Birmingham nor to limit lawful picketing and other activity carried out in accordance with the existing injunction granted by the High Court against Unite and in favour of Birmingham City Council (94468/27 May 2025, extended on 29 May and applied to the Smithfield Depot on 25 June 2025).

The application will be heard on 10 July 2025 and will be notified separately in which representations will be able to be made.

Take Notice: If the application is granted, anyone breaching the injunction could be imprisoned for up to 2 years, fined, and/or have their assets seized for contempt of court.
