

1. I, Glenn Marriott for Expert Investigations Ltd of [REDACTED] will state:
2. I am a Process Server acting under the direction of DLA Piper UK LLP and this statement has been prepared based on evidence collated by myself.
3. At 1421hrs on Thursday 5th February 2026 I received an email from Lotte Frorup, DLA Piper containing an A5 sized Notice of Injunction Application Hearing Date. I printed off 200 of these Notices for distribution to protestors at the following Depots.
4. At 0600hrs Thursday 12th February 2026 I attended Perry Barr Depot, Holford Drive, Birmingham, B42 6HX. There were a total of 10 protestors at the location. One of the protestors took possession of a leaflet and threw it in the bin and the others refused to take possession of the leaflets.
5. At 0625hrs Thursday 12th February, I attended Smithfield Depot, Sherlock Street, Birmingham, B5 6HX in order to hand out leaflets to protestors. There were approximately 30 protestors at the location, some wearing face coverings. Leaflets were handed out to 20 of the protestors and the other 10 refused to take possession of one.
6. At 0645hrs same day, I attended Atlas Depot, 70-172, Kings Road, Tysley, B11 2AS in order to hand out leaflets to protestors. There were 4 protestors located at the staff entrance and leaflets were taken by 3 of them. At the main entrance there were approximately 40 protestors present. Leaflets were handed out to 18 of the protestors and the others refused.
7. At 0721hrs same day, I attended Lifford Lane Depot, Ebury Road, Kings Norton, Birmingham, B30 3JJ. There were 8 protestors present at the location and all of them took one of the leaflets.
8. Photographs were taken at the 4 x Depots attended and are attached as Exhibit GM/8


