7. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026**. 8. New applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy or emergency proxy) must be received by the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026**. Some applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote>.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown below by **5pm on Thursday 7 May 2026**.
