

ECO4 Announcement

Birmingham City Council regrets to announce the closure of the ECO4 Flex Scheme following the Chancellor's 2025 Autumn Budget, which confirmed the end of the green levy and, consequently, the end of ECO4 funding. As a result, our installers partners, City Energy and Next Energy, are no longer able to secure funding from energy companies.

Although ECO4 will continue nationally until December 2026, no new applications can be funded. This extension period is intended solely to allow energy suppliers to complete any outstanding remedial works and cover any overspend in their current targets. The GBIS scheme ended on 31 March 2026.

Due to these budget constraints and the fact that ECO4 is funded by energy companies and not the Council we are unable to progress any new applications. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.
