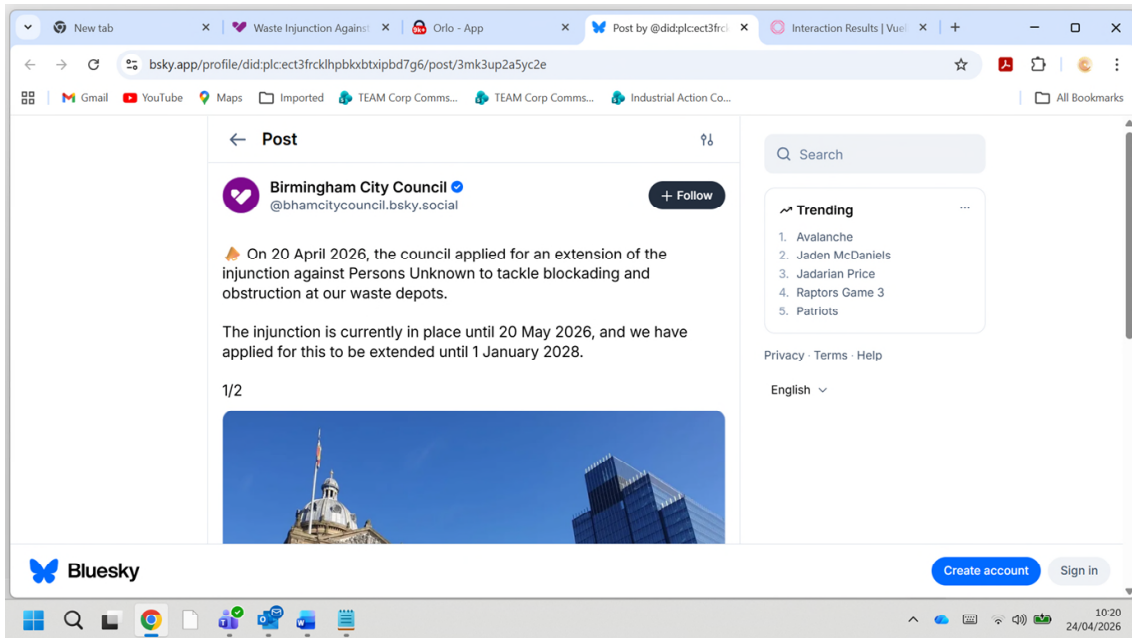

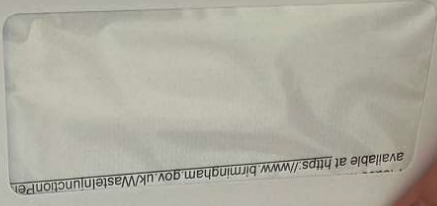

I, Saab Samra, process server of Tremark Associates Limited, instructed for service by DLA Piper UK LLP, make this Witness Statement and WILL SAY as follows: -

1. I attended Perry Barr Depot (Holford Drive) Perry Barr, Birmingham, West Midlands, B42 2TU at 05.58 on 24th April 2026 and served 20 notices. There were approx. 9-10 persons unknown on site at the time of attending. The notices were put straight in the bin by one of the individuals on site.
2. I attended at Smithfields Depot, (Sherlock Street), Birmingham, West Midlands, B5 6HX at 06.12 hours and affixed 15 copies of the notices, in a clear plastic sleeve to the railings on site.
3. I attended at Atlas Depot, 70-172 Kings Road, Tyseley, Birmingham, B11 2AS (Redfern Road) and served 40 copies of the notices with a similar amount of Persons Unknown on site at 06.30 hours. I was videoed while on site, the group were rather aggressive, with one all suited up, took the lead and was in my face for the duration. However, we departed on friendly terms.

I attended at Lifford Lane Depot, (Ebury Road), Kings Norton, Birmingham, West Midlands, B30 3JJ at 06.55 hours and served approx. 30 copies of the notices, by placing them on the floor in the presence of the persons unknown. I was informed that I was harassing them and next time the police would be called.

4. A true copy of the Notice so served by me is now produced to me and marked exhibit 'A'.
