A certificate for the summary review of the premises licence granted to +Venture Battersea Limited in respect of Luna Springs, 18 – 19 Hack Street, Birmingham, B9 4AH was submitted to the Licensing Authority by West Midlands Police on 12th May 2026 under section 53A of the Licensing Act 2003 as amended by the Violent Crime Reduction Act 2006.

Reasons for the summary review:

The Chief Constable of West Midlands Police has given a certificate that in his opinion the premises are associated with serious crime and / or serious disorder (or both). At approximately 19.00hours on Saturday 9th May 2026 an incident occurred at the premises whereby two males received injuries. This matter has resulted in two Section 18 woundings being recorded.
