A certificate for the summary review of the premises licence granted to DAN86 LTD in respect of King of the Clubs, Hill Street, Birmingham, B5 4AH was submitted to the Licensing Authority by West Midlands Police on 27th May 2026 under section 53A of the Licensing Act 2003 as amended by the Violent Crime Reduction Act 2006.

Reasons for the summary review:

The Chief Constable of West Midlands Police has given a certificate that in his opinion the premises are associated with serious crime and / or serious disorder (or both). At approximately 2236hours on Saturday 23rd May 2026 an incident occurred whereby a violent disorder occurred involving in excess of 100 people using items as weapons.
