

A Better Future

As part of its plan to ensure that the people of Birmingham have a high quality of life, the City Council is drawing up proposals to improve the neighbourhood at Meadway.

These are initial proposals for consultation and comment. The proposals include providing new high quality homes and improved and new facilities at Kent's Moat Recreation Ground.

The objectives of the proposals are to provide:

- A mix of homes for sale and affordable homes for rent and low cost home ownership in a range of different house types that meet the needs of the community and gives people a choice of homes
- Homes built to improve the security of existing homes on the perimeter of the park
- Homes built to high energy efficiency standards to reduce impact on the environment
- Funding to improve the park, providing a more welcoming, safer and higher quality usable area of open space
- A park that is better overlooked to improve safety and reduce crime.
- New footpaths, planting and seating areas
- New play facilities and playing pitches

We are seeking your views about the emerging proposals as they would involve a loss of some of the existing park around the perimeter. The existing park is 11.84ha (29.26 acres) and the above proposals would result in a loss of 19.5% 2.3ha (5.68 acres) of the park.

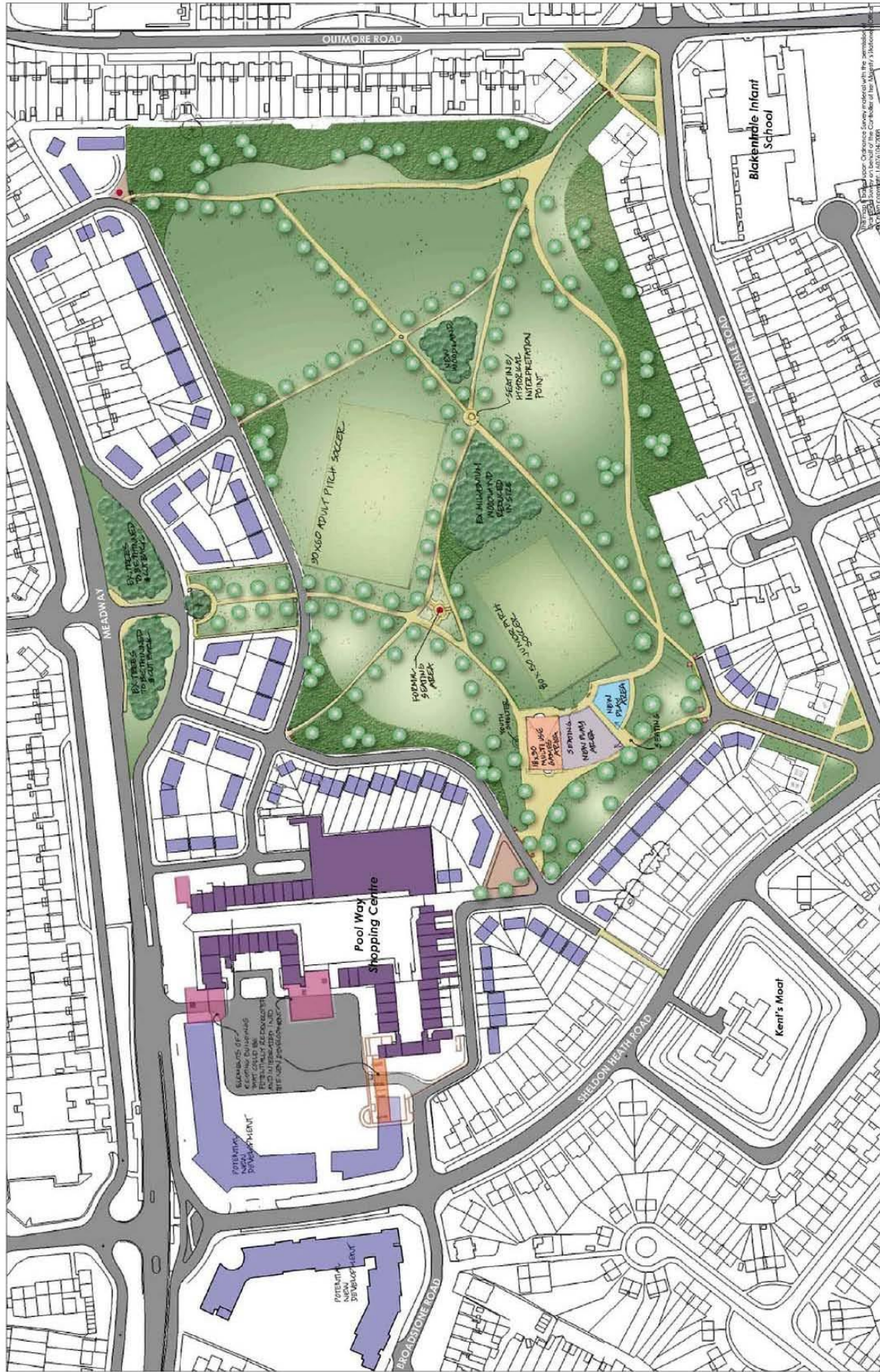
