Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 53

- The path is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1880's).
- The path is shown on the Footpaths Map of Warwickshire (Section One) published by the Ramblers Association (Midland Federation) in 1937. A printed note on the map states that "only those tracks, which, from the best information available, are understood to be reputed public ways" are shown on it.
