## Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 243

- The path is first recorded, and labelled "Footway", on the map with the Northfield Tithe Apportionment of 1840. (Held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library.)
- The path is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1880's).
- Most of the path has been lost under the schools, but there is no known Highway Diversion Order.
- The remaining path has a well maintained tarmac, or paved, surface with modern street lighting and high, metal, security fencing to the schools on both sides.
- The path is recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
