

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 306

- The path is first recorded on the deposited plans for the Wolverhampton, Walsall and Midland Junction Railway 1871. The Book of Reference describes item 1a, in Minworth, as "Public Foot Road", with the owner being the Surveyor of Highways. (Held by the Warwickshire County Record Office at QS111/308.)
- The whole path is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1880s).
- The area had started to be developed by 1952, with the estate roads replacing the path (including across the railway), according to the Ordnance Survey 1/25,000 Sheet SP19 Sutton Coldfield.
- Development of the whole are had been completed by 1976, according to the Ordnance Survey 1/25,000 sheet SP09/19 Sutton Coldfield and Walsall.
- No Highway Diversion, or Closure, Orders, however, have been found.
- The remaining section of the path is partly paved and partly rough surfaced, but with some public services along it.
- 7 This path is recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
