

#### Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 238

- The path is first recorded on the map with the Northfield Tithe Apportionment of 1840. (Held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library.)

  Although this is not evidence that it is actually a public right of way, in every case where there is evidence, they have all been shown to be public rights of way.
- The path is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1880's).
- The path is also shown, and labelled 'FP', on the Ordnance Survey 1/25,000 sheet SP08 (1952,1970).
- 4 The path was not closed for the construction of Bartley Reservoir.
- There is an iron gate at Genners Lane, with the claimed path being one of a number of well trodden paths across the grass to Frankley Lane.
- The path is recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
