## THURSDAY 12 DECEMBER 2019

1. An election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve for each of the above-named Constituencies.
2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer at the Elections Office, Council House, Victoria Square B1 1BB, between 10.00 am and 4.00 pm on any week day after the date of this notice (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4.00 pm on **Thursday 14 November 2019**.
3. Nomination papers may be obtained from the offices of the (Acting) Returning Officer at the Elections Office, Council House, Victoria Square, Birmingham B1 1BB at the times mentioned above.
4. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 12 December 2019.
5. The £500 deposit can be paid when submitting papers by:
  - Legal tender (notes or pound coins); or
  - Bankers draft (drawn by a UK bank and made payable to “Acting Returning Officer, Birmingham”) or
  - Debit or credit card (Delta, Solo, Switch/Maestro, Mastercard or Visa) or the electronic transfer of funds.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Elections Office, Council House, Victoria Square B1 1BB by 12 midnight on Tuesday 26 November 2019.
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Elections Office, Council House, Victoria Square, Birmingham B1 1BB by 5.00 pm on Tuesday 26 November 2019.
8. Applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Elections Office, Council House, Victoria Square, Birmingham B1 1BB by 5.00 pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Elections Office, Council House, Victoria Square, Birmingham B1 1BB by 5.00 pm on Thursday 12 December 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5.00pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5.00pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
