Notice of Proposed Adoption of Proposals for the alteration of  
Kings Norton Business Centre Simplified Planning Zone*

On 4<sup>th</sup> October 2017, Birmingham City Council adopted these scheme proposals.

The proposals became operative on their adoption, but any person aggrieved by the proposals who desires to question their validity on the ground that they are not within the powers conferred by Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the adoption of the proposals, may, six weeks from 4<sup>th</sup> October 2017, make an application to the High Court under section 287 of the 1990 Act.
