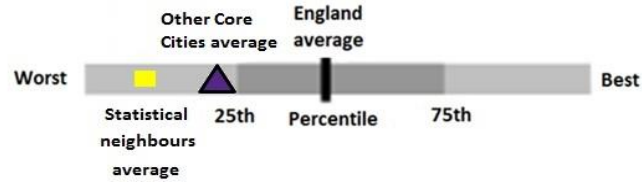


# Birmingham NHS Outcomes Framework Apr 2016
