Disability Awareness & Safeguarding Training Course for Private Hire Drivers

Disability Resource Centre provide a half day training course for private hire drivers applying for an operating licence from Birmingham City Council.

Attending the course and passing a short test at the end is a requirement of getting your licence from Birmingham City Council.

Our courses usually take place once a month depending on demand from drivers. If you would like to attend a course, please contact us directly to book a place by returning this form to us.

The cost of the course is £60.00 which must be paid on arrival, payments can be made by cash or card. You must pay the full payment and show us your photo-driving licence on the morning of the course. Failure to bring payment or photo-driving licence will mean you will have to be booked onto a future course.

At the end of the course there will be a short half-hour test based on the topics covered during the training. You must answer at least 8 out of 10 questions correctly to pass the course. We will then notify Birmingham City Council Licencing Department of all successful candidates.
