The Hearing Support Team supports babies, children, young people and their families in mainstream schools, special schools, colleges, universities, early years settings and homes. It helps those who have a diagnosed hearing impairment and who use hearing aids or cochlear implants.

We offer:

- Enabling access to the full curriculum
- Successful inclusion birth to 25

We receive referrals from ENT consultants, audiologists, schools, other services and parents.

The team are:

- Qualified teachers of the deaf
- Specialist teaching assistants
- Educational audiologist
- Audiological technicians
- Sign language tutor

Mainstream, special and post-16 settings

We aim to raise the achievement and promote the inclusion of children and young people with hearing impairment, both at school and beyond.

We are able to provide:

- Individual teaching
- In-class support
- Audiological assessment and technical support (e.g. radio aids)
- Training for all staff including deaf awareness and bespoke courses
- Customised, nationally accredited sign language courses
- Advice on communication, language and literacy
- Advice on differentiation
- Advice on the acoustic/ listening environment
- Specialist assessments and advice for Education, Health and Care Plans
- Advice on traditional target setting, GCSEs, A Levels and vocational courses



- Advice and guidance to parents and school staff
- Liaison with health and other agencies
